Re: Yukon Government proposed EPR Regulation

The Yukon Government has announced its intention to add used oil materials to a new Extended Producer Responsibility Regulation. The Yukon Government has advised that its proposed regulatory framework will align with and mirror the BC Recycling Regulation. This would mean that if you sell products or original equipment in the Yukon then you would have similar obligations as you do in British Columbia.
