



## Notice of Interchange Yukon Implementation EHCs

March 3, 2025

Following approval of our Stewardship Plan by the Yukon Government, Interchange Recycling is launching a program in Yukon on August 1, 2025. The program covers the following materials: lubricating oil, antifreeze, diesel exhaust fluid, oil filters, and automotive containers. A complete applicable products list is available on our [website](#).

In anticipation of the program launch, we are pleased to share the Implementation EHCs required for the program's operation.

### Yukon Implementation EHCs (effective July 1, 2025)

Product Category	Proposed EHCs
Lubricating Oil	\$0.12 per litre
Automotive Containers HDPE or Metal	\$0.26 per litre / container size
Automotive Containers Non-HDPE or Metal	\$0.60 per litre / container size
Windshield Washer Fluid Containers HDPE	\$0.26 per litre / container size
Filters Less than 8" and all sump type filters	\$0.98 per unit
Filters Equal to or greater than 8"	\$2.18 per unit

Glycol / Antifreeze Concentrate / Antifreeze Premix	\$0.38 per litre
Glycol / Antifreeze Containers	\$0.26 per litre / container size
Automotive Aerosol Containers	\$0.53 per unit
Diesel Exhaust Fluid Containers	\$0.26 per litre / container size
Diesel Exhaust Fluid	\$0.00

**Membership & Planning Fees**

- For Q1 and Q2 of 2025, planning fees will remain in effect as we prepare for full program implementation. Please submit your reports through [The Vault](#). *Note: planning fees will cease at the end of Q2 2025, with the new implementation fees taking effect on July 1, 2025.*
- If your company is selling obligated products in Yukon, we encourage you to register with Interchange Recycling to ensure compliance and participation in the program. For existing and new members, please ensure your [Participation Agreement for Yukon](#) is signed and that you are up to date with all reporting requirements.
- Even if you are registered in [The Vault](#) for BC, separate registration is required for the Yukon program. Detailed instructions on how to do this can be found on Page 19 of [The Vault Training Manual](#).

We are committed to supporting our members and ensuring a smooth transition into the Yukon program. To help you stay ahead of compliance requirements and avoid potential complications, we strongly encourage you to register and submit your reports as soon as possible. Please note that delaying registration may result in retroactive planning fee obligations dating back to July 2024 for companies that have not yet started collecting these fees.
