



## Reminder of Reporting Updates (BC & Yukon) *Effective January 1, 2026*

December 2, 2025

Dear Members,

As outlined in our notice dated October 2, 2025, Interchange Recycling will introduce updated reporting requirements beginning January 1, 2026. These changes support compliance with both British Columbia and Yukon regulations and approved EPR Plans.

Across both regions, members will now be required to report container category, material type, and container size for each SKU. Updated reporting fields will be available in *The Vault* on January 1, 2026. Below is a summary of what's changing in each jurisdiction.

### **BRITISH COLUMBIA**

BC's updated requirements include new automotive container categories and the introduction of reporting by material type (e.g., HDPE, Bag-in-Box, PET, Metal).

#### **Expanded Container Categories (effective 2026)**

Collection in BC will now cover additional empty automotive containers identified under Schedule 5 of the Recycling Regulation, including:

- Automotive aerosols
- Boosters
- Brake fluid
- Conditioners
- Degreasers
- Fuel system cleaners
- Lubricants
- Sealants
- Solvents
- Stabilizers
- Windshield washer fluid

#### **Reporting Requirements**

Each SKU will now require:

1. Container Category (e.g., oil, antifreeze, degreasers, lubricants)
2. Material Type (HDPE, metal, PET, Bag-in-Box, PVC, multi-layer, other)
3. Container Size (<1 L, 1–5 L, >5 L)

### **BC EHC Rates (unchanged)**

- \$0.17/L – HDPE / Metal
- \$0.40/L – Non-HDPE / Non-Metal

EHCs apply based on the material type of each container.

## **YUKON**

The Yukon update introduces reporting by material type but does not add new container categories or change existing EHC rates.

### **Container Categories (unchanged)**

Members will continue to report the following categories in *The Vault*:

- Oil containers
- Antifreeze containers
- DEF containers
- Automotive aerosols
- Boosters
- Brake fluid
- Conditioners
- Degreasers
- Fuel system cleaners
- Lubricants
- Sealants
- Solvents
- Stabilizers
- Windshield washer fluid

### **Reporting Requirements**

Each SKU will now require:

1. Container Category (e.g., oil, antifreeze, degreasers, lubricants)
2. Material Type (HDPE, metal, PET, Bag-in-Box, PVC, multi-layer, other)
3. Container Size (<1 L, 1–5 L, >5 L)

### **Yukon EHC Rates (unchanged)**

- \$0.26/L – HDPE / Metal
- \$0.60/L – Non-HDPE / Non-Metal

EHCs continue to be assessed based on material type.
